What are the focus areas for your Board?

Questions

The default GVO Skills Audit is based on the NGA model, but can easily be edited to ensure the questions are bespoke for your school or Board. Amend the questions and categories to align with your own strategic and Governance priorities.



Completion

Each Governor or Trustee simply completes (or updates) their numerical responses via their profile, based on their own experiences and knowledge. Responses can be updated at anytime, with the reporting tool showing when an individual last completed the audit.



Reporting

Once the Audit has been completed, use the Reporting tool to collate the responses at the click of a button. Colour coded reports by question and category highlight the strengths and gaps. Reports can be shared and exported for further analysis and strategic planning.
